#### **Light Up the Season**

Light Up the Season made a triumphant in-person return in 2021. We are deeply grateful to the Board – in partnership with the Four Seasons Hotel, Washington, DC – for raising \$104,000 for our patients through this beloved event. The fifth installment of Light Up the Season paired six patients with local designers and artists to create heartwarming seasonal décor, including four holiday trees, a menorah and a vignette.

Nell, a teen who partnered with Design Collaborative DC, said one of the best parts of participating in the event was connecting with other Children's National patients. She was thrilled to meet Amari, another patient artist whose story she had seen earlier that year on local TV news. "I enjoyed seeing the other patient designs and how they expressed their stories."

### Children's Ball 2022

Your partnership elevated the return of Children's Ball 2022 to new heights this year. The celebration, held April 2 at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, raised nearly \$3.9 million for patients and families. The Board's generosity secured \$226,000 toward that amount, making the 2022 Ball one of the most successful in hospital history. Your dedication to the event advances **follow the leader**, our comprehensive fundraising campaign to transform the health and well-being of future leaders.

### Making Sickle Cell Disease Less Painful

This year the Board makes it possible to revolutionize pain management for children living with sickle cell disease. Your collective \$1 million gift enables our world-class team to establish a patient-centric, holistic pain management program. This initiative will pioneer new ways to reduce pain, increase coping skills and improve mental health.
